MyWIC secured a Philadelphia Youth Network Grant to provide a 6-week long program in partnership with NAWIC Philadelphia Foundation and Girl's Inc. during which they provided 12 trade days for construction industry and "hands on" exploration. The 2020 program was July 6 - August 21 for twenty 12-14 year old girls. They gained exposure to architecture, engineering, innovative techniques, program management, estimating, and trade construction.
